May 21, 2020 Update:

Even if courses are online, many students will still want to live in residence. Carleton is working closely with Ottawa Public Health to adapt our spaces in residence and ensure that living on campus will be safe and will remain an exceptional experience for students. The steps being taken include, but are not limited to, single room spaces in traditional- and suite-style residences, increased cleaning practices in communal areas, support for those requiring isolation immediately before or during their time in residence, and decreased density in all areas.

Some dates, deadlines and fees to be aware of:

- Students accepting their offer of residence by 4:00 p.m. on June 8, 2020 will be guaranteed a space in residence for either September-April or January-April.
- Students must confirm their commitment to join us in residence, for either a September or a January start date, with Housing and Residence Life Services by 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2020.
- Students joining in September will have single occupancy in either a single room or a double room.
 - Those living in a single room will be charged a single room rate.
 - Those living in a double room may be placed with a roommate if restrictions are lifted.
 These students will be charged a double room rate.
- Students wishing to cancel residence for September-April with a full refund of the deposit may do so by 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2020.
- Students wishing to cancel residence for January-April with a full refund of the deposit may do so by 4:00 pm on October 30, 2020.
