Eligible students must be entering or continuing any program of study and residing in a Carleton University residence during 2026-27. The recipient showing a strong dedication to the residence community, will receive \$1,000. This bursary was endowed in 2023 by the Department of Housing and Residence Life. **An application is required.**
